**Duty Roster**


<p><b>Camp Setup Procedure</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pitch dining fly then put all patrol and personal gear underneath.</li> <li>2. Pitch tents only (no personal gear yet).</li> <li>3. Set up chuck box and stove.</li> <li>4. Put personal sleeping gear in tents.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Camp Takedown Procedure</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pack personal gear, make pack line in camp site under dining fly.</li> <li>2. Clean and pack chuck box and stove.</li> <li>3. Drop and pack tents.</li> <li>4. Drop and pack dining fly.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Stove/Lantern Lighting Procedure</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Check all valves and both burners are closed and everything is cooled.</li> <li>2. Check fuel in tank and secure fuel cap. Make sure stove is level.</li> <li>3. Unscrew pump handle 2 turns, pump 30 strokes, close.</li> <li>4. For stove, turn lighting lever on valve so that it points up.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Stove/Lantern Lighting Procedure (continued)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. Hold flame source near right burner (stove) or mantle (lantern).</li> <li>6. Open valve fully and verify lighting.</li> <li>7. After lantern light is white or stove flame is all blue, turn lighting lever down and adjust valve to desired level.</li> <li>8. Light second burner if needed. Introduce flame BEFORE opening valve.</li> </ol>
